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Missions of Library

- 1 Managing scholarly information such as books, journals, and electronic resources
- 2 Managing and maintaining the information infrastructure for the Library Catalog and library services
- 3 Promoting “Open Science” which helps academic achievements be shared with the public
- 4 Supporting research data preservation and management
- 5 Supporting and promoting library use

Serving as the institute-wide foundation that supports educational and research activities at Science Tokyo, the institute libraries create a nexus where knowledge accumulates and intersects.

Through collecting, managing and providing scholarly information, the libraries also promote the creation and dissemination of new knowledge for future generations.

Science Tokyo has four libraries: the Ookayama Library, the Ochanomizu Library, the Konodai Library and the Suzukakedai Library. These libraries work together to provide scholarly materials such as books, journals, e-books, e-journals, and databases, by operating the collection search system and related infrastructure.

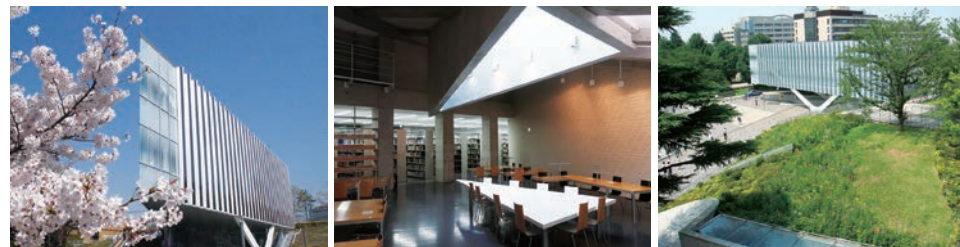
The libraries also provide support for open science and research data management, so that the public can widely and easily get access to the results of research conducted at Science Tokyo.

Ookayama Library

Good Design Award Winner

The Ookayama Library, designed by the Koichi Yasuda Laboratory of Architecture and Building Engineering*, the Facilities Department*, and the Tokyo Institute of Technology Library*, was completed in 2011. The Library has reading spaces and stacks including the electrical compact shelving on the two underground floors. The upper two floors of glass triangle shape are learning commons and studying space. While collecting rare journals in science and engineering fields as a library of the National Center for Overseas Periodicals, the Library supports the study/research of students and faculty/staff with a wide range of materials from liberal arts such as classic literature to materials for language study besides large numbers of science and engineering books.

Konodai Library

Where Future Scientists and Medical Professionals Grow Up

The Konodai Library is mainly for first-year undergraduate students. In addition to academic science books, the Library has books on a wide range of topics in the sciences and humanities as well as literary works. It has various facilities, including a reading room where students can concentrate on reading and studying in a quiet environment, surrounded by nature. It also provides a collaboration area for group sessions, a presentation room, and a Learning Commons. In addition, the library offers a PC rental service that students can use freely within the building. Though it is small, the Konodai Library meets and satisfies various intellectual needs of students.

Ochanomizu Library

Medical and Dental Library in Sacred Academic Areas

The Ochanomizu Library in the Yushima Campus is located in Shoheizaka, Yushima known as sacred areas for academics and education. The Library moved to the newly built M&D Tower (on the 3rd and 4th floors) in 2010, featuring a central reading room atrium and large glass walls. A broad library collection consists of a wide range of medical and dental materials covering from historical books such as “Kaitai Shinsho” to the latest e-journals and e-books, besides various textbooks and reference books for students and clinical journals for hospital staff. Most of the materials are stacked in Automated Storage and Retrieval System in the basement.

Suzukakedai Library

Multi-purpose Place for All Library Users

The three-story Suzukakedai Library was renovated in 2021 to enlarge the spaces where students can concentrate on their studying and research.

The newly-born Library is equipped with a variety of spaces such as Seminar Rooms for individual or group use, Personal Research Areas that have various types of individual seats with a door or a sofa for presentation practice or job hunting, and a Multi-Purpose Room for seminars or events to meet any demands. This is not a place only for users of library materials.
